PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS . . .

October 9 – Minoo Rakhsha spoke to us about Growing up in Iran. Minoo is a CPA in Amy Gardner's firm of Lindsay Gardner CPAs. While growing up in Tehran, Iran, she studied math and taught math for 13 years. She has 4 sisters and 1 brother – all are very intelligent and have professional careers. Minoo came to the United States in 1996 due to an arranged marriage. In 1999 she began her accounting profession, and became a United States citizen in 2002. This was all topped by passing the CPA exam and becoming licensed in 2003. As best as she and Amy can tell, Minoo is the first and only first generation Iranian to be licensed in North Carolina. As for a dress code while in Iran, women must keep their heads covered while in public. Now at home, they have the option to cover or not. Minoo brought and wore to show us various options for coverings. Along with her presentation, she had a slide show that indicated that Iran is a beautiful country.

October 16 – Michael Kelly, the Associate ACC Commissioner, spoke to us regarding the "Road to Tampa." Seven weeks from tomorrow is the ACC Championship game, being held this year in Tampa Bay, Florida. Following a brief video to get us all in the football spirit, Michael talked about the fact that last year 10 teams went on to bowl games. At this year's championship game, there will be events honoring award winners, an ACC Legends event, and a pep rally through downtown Tampa. Also, the game will be shown at 8 p.m. – during prime time. Next season's championship game will be held at Bank of America Stadium in Charlotte, and Michael encouraged us to take part.
