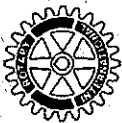

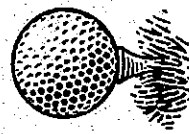

RULE OF 85. Rotary International states " A member's absence shall be excused if:

* the absence complies with the conditions and under circumstances approved by the board. The board may excuse a member's absence for reasons which it considers to be good and sufficient.

* the aggregate of the member's years of age and years of membership in one or more clubs is 85 years or more and the member has notified the club secretary in writing of the member's desire to be excused from attendance and the board has approved.

(NOTE: The rule above allows the club not to count the member in the total membership of the club. Ex: Total Membership is 100 and 5 members are RULE OF 85, then the attendance of the club would be computed as follows 45 members present 45/95 = 47% NOT 45/100 = 45%)"

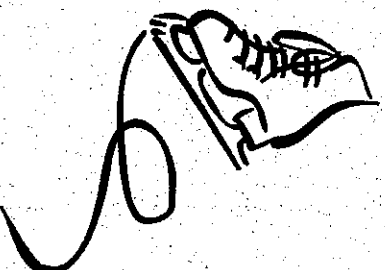

February 26 – Hill Carrow, CEO of Sports & Properties, Inc. spoke about the 2011 U.S. Figure Skating Championships to be performed in Greensboro. He just returned from Vancouver and reports that figure skating – women's especially – is the most popular sport among ladies. Following a brief video, he talked about the Championship, which has never been held in the Carolinas. It will be held January 22-30, 2011, and will take at least 500 volunteers. March 5 – Governor Beverly Perdue was the special guest speaker at Reynolda Rotary today.
