## **MEMBERSHIP NEWS . . .**

- **JACOB DAHLIN** and his family are traveling to Sweden for a couple weeks. Jacob is originally from Sweden, and his parents and a brother still live there. While there, Jacob is giving a presentation to a Rotary club and has taken 2 of our club banners with him.

## **PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS . . .**

*July 30* – Today was the annual District Governor's visit. This year's DG is Wes Patterson. Each committee presented a brief report on what their goals are for the year. Following those reports, DG Patterson made a few comments:



- Encourage Gaines Scholarship recipients to apply (during their junior year) for an Ambassadorial Scholarship.
- Asked that we consider applying for a District Grant (formerly known as District Simplified Grant). Club can apply for up to \$4000.
- RI was challenged by the Gates Foundation to raise \$200 million for Polio. After only 1 year, RI has raised \$140 million. The District has raised \$232,000 of their projected \$350,000 for polio.
- The very popular Triad Flight of Honor will have 3 additional flights this fall. DG Patterson indicated this program would end when we ran out of veterans for these trips.
- Wants to see us retain more of our members. That's Rotary's problem – they easily get new members but have trouble retaining their current members.

Architecture. Rence presented a slide presentation of buildings built after 1900 such as Wachovia (our first skyscraper built in 1911), 1915 Post Office, 1931 Centenary Church, 1966 Wachovia (now Winston Tower), 1975 Hall of Justice, 1987 One Triad Park (which is very similar to the Allied Bank Building in Texas), and the 1995 Wachovia Center built by Caesar Pelli. The Southern Bell Building (built in 1928) was the first building in Winston-Salem using the art deco design. The Benton Convention Center, built in 1969, was the first convention center built by the firm that created it. Rence said it is being proposed for downtown Winston-Salem to have pylons outside of certain buildings telling of his construction history.

*August 6* – Rence Callahan, Vice President of Walter Robbs Pierce and Callahan, brought a very interesting program about 20<sup>th</sup> Century Downtown Winston-Salem
