PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS . . .

December 1 – Paul Norby, Director of the Winston-Salem City/County Planning Board was today’s guest speaker. Along with a slide presentation, he told us that Winston-Salem is growing, and that’s a good thing. It’s not whether you grow but how you grow. The planning board looks at sprawl, balanced growth, places for economic growth, transportation and accessibility, mixed use areas, attractiveness and livability, and a city center. Also up for further consideration is streetcars. Adding streetcars to our streets would support higher density residential areas, move students and tourists, and would provide a convenience of not having to hunt for parking spaces. All-in-all, the planning board tries to create more livable spaces for a sustainable future.
