January 24 - Kurt Waldthausen, a partner at Coleman Lew & Associates spoke today about the Political Relationship between Germany and the U.S. Kurt is from Germany, so this gave us the German perspective. Germany's reaction to 9/11 is solidarity with the U.S. No other nation donated more. So how did we get to our present discord? Germans have strong feelings about a war with Iraq. What are likely repercussions? Will it cause more destabilization? After 9/11, it is clear that the entire world is living in a time of change/turmoil.

January 31 - Mike Butler, Scout Executive of the Old Hickory Council was today's speaker. Boy Scouts was founded in 1910 in the U.S. Mike recognized many in attendance who have been either volunteers or had youngsters in the program. Specifically, Mike recognized Bighouse Gaines, who has been involved in scouts for many, many years. In fact, on May 21 (Bighouse's 80th birthday), Bighouse will be awarded the Silver Buffalo Award during a ceremony at the Benton Convention Center. The Silver Buffalo is the highest award that can be bestowed on anyone. Scouts are not like your dad might remember. Now there are even more available to today's youth. "Learning for Life" is a new program, which is school-based (K-12) with age appropriate curriculum. Because it is in the schools, girls can take part. "Venturing" is the traditional program for young people ages 14-20. This allows young men to stay in scouting longer, and also allows young women to learn the same leadership skills, do the same group activities, etc. as the men. Scouting does make a difference, and the programs are as strong as ever!

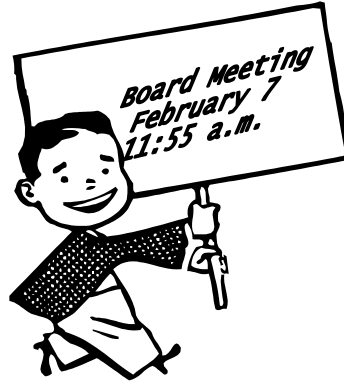
